### SEP 28 PILANSBERG NATIONAL PARK / JOHANNESBURG

An early morning wake-up call and out into the bush on the morning safari in search of animals not seen the day before. Return to camp for a hearty breakfast, and then relax at the camp until time to transfer overland to Johannesburg where you are met and assisted to the shuttle transfer to your reserved hotel.

### SEP 29 JOHANNESBURG / MAHÉ, SEYCHELLES

Transfer by hotel shuttle to the airport and board your flight to Mahe, Seychelles. On arrival at Mahé airport today, you are transferred to your hotel.

For anyone looking for an unspoiled tropical paradise thousands of miles from anywhere, where one can lie on palm-fringed beaches, swim in warm, crystal-clear seas and just relax, the Seychelles islands are the answer. Discover the wonderful stretch of sparkling ivory sands on the western tip of the Seychelles in the bay of the famous and picturesque Beau Vallon Beach. Lush gardens create an inspiring atmosphere for a romantic idyll or serene getaway.

Enjoy the experience of the Le Meridien Fisherman's Cove which possesses a history dating back to 1943, making it the first and most legendary hotel in the islands.

Located in the main building, Superior Rooms provide ample space to rest and relax in our tropical paradise. Each room features a large private terrace that faces the dazzling blue sea. Cool tiles grace the room's floor. A refreshment center is fully stocked for added convenience. The hotel offers an aqua gym, swimming pool, lighted tennis courts, beach games, snorkeling and walking trails. All non-motorized water sports, such as canoeing and snorkeling are available to guests at no charge.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW FOR YOUR JOURNEY TO:****SEYCHELLES****For SEYCHELLES:**

Visitors are advised to have at least one blank page available in their passport for each entry into the Seychelles. **Passport must be valid at least six months beyond the intended period of stay in Seychelles.**

- **Travel Health Information**

Please consult your personal physician or local health department for recommended inoculations at least 6 weeks prior to travel. Anti-malaria medications are recommended for many African countries and some require yellow fever vaccination.

Yellow fever vaccination is compulsory **IF** traveling from or through a country with risk of yellow fever transmission, including travelers in transit for more than 12 hours in an airport located in a country with risk of yellow fever transmission. In such cases, a yellow fever certificate is required upon entry into any port of debarkation in Seychelles.

- **Excess Luggage Storage**

You may store the remainder of your luggage at a baggage storage facility at Mahe International Airport at your own expense, for collection by you after your stay. Storage fees are subject to change.

- **Currency Exchange & Credit Cards**

Effective year 2014-2015, banks, hotel and shops in Seychelles no longer accept American bank notes printed before 2006. Any currency, with dates of 2005 and earlier, is no longer usable.
